

Pastor Rob McCoy & Hon. Michele Bachmann Join 1,000+ Witnesses Calling on Candace Owens and Tucker Carlson to Repent of Antisemitism in Jesus Name

Momentum grows for "The Truth in Love Declaration" as major conservative voices and media outlets like CBN News rally to defend the integrity of the Church.

JERUSALEM / WASHINGTON D.C. – January 30, 2026 – Following its launch on International Holocaust Remembrance Day, "The Truth in Love Declaration" has gained significant international momentum, crossing **1,000 public signatories** in less than one week.

The Declaration, which issues a formal theological rebuke against the "unrepentant Jew-hatred and false witness" broadcast by figures including Candace Owens, Tucker Carlson, and Nick Fuentes, has now garnered the support of major figures in the American Church and conservative movement.

A Significant Development: Rob McCoy and Michele Bachmann

In a major development for the initiative, **Pastor Rob McCoy** (Pastor Emeritus, Godspeak Calvary Chapel), a prominent leader in the conservative Christian movement, has publicly signed the Declaration. By doing so, Pastor McCoy joins a growing chorus of leaders formally calling on Candace Owens and Tucker Carlson to repent of their rhetoric and to stop using the name of Jesus to validate antisemitism.

Pastor McCoy is well-known for being Charlie Kirk's pastor, helping Kirk found Turning Point Faith in 2021.

Joining Pastor McCoy is the **Hon. Michele Bachmann** (Former U.S. Congresswoman and Dean of the Robertson School of Government at Regent University), further underscoring that this is not a fringe issue, but a concern reaching the highest levels of Christian leadership.

Media Coverage & Growing Consensus

The initiative has sparked widespread conversation, with coverage from **CBN News** ([Jerusalem Dateline](#)) and [Israel365 News](#) highlighting the urgent nature of this firewall against antisemitism within the Church.

The Declaration continues to be anchored by its initial influential signatories, including **Rev. Dr. Gerald McDermott** (Anglican theologian), **Pastor Dumisani Washington** (Institute for Black Solidarity with Israel), and Dr. Jim Garlow (Well Versed).

Spiritual Duty, Not Political Censorship

Organizers reiterate that this movement operates outside of political partisanship. As the Declaration website states: *"We value political liberty. We are not silencing their legal right to speak; we are exercising our spiritual duty to rebuke."*

"Our hope is that these notable developments make this Declaration a helpful and much-needed tool for the wider Body of Christ in this serious hour," said John Enarson, one of the initiative's organizers. "When over 1,000 witnesses, including pastors like Rob McCoy and theologians like Dr. McDermott, stand together, it sends a clear message: You cannot claim to love the King of the Jews while reviling His kinsmen according to the flesh (Romans 9:3-5)."
