

Christian Coalition Launches "Truth in Love Declaration" Ahead of International Holocaust Remembrance Day, Calling Out "Unrepentant Jew-Hatred" from Owens, Carlson, and Fuentes

JERUSALEM / WASHINGTON D.C. — January 26, 2026 — On the eve of International Holocaust Remembrance Day (Jan 27), a coalition of Christian pastors, theologians, and ministry leaders has released “**The Truth in Love Declaration**,” a formal theological statement categorically condemning the rise of antisemitic rhetoric and Holocaust revisionism within the Christian Right.

The Declaration explicitly rebukes the "unrepentant Jew-hatred and false witness" of media figures **Candace Owens, Tucker Carlson, and Nick Fuentes**—and those following their example—citing a pattern of "reviving ancient blood libels, demonizing Israel with double standards, and generalizing guilt to the Jewish people" while invoking the name of Jesus.

Initiated by concerned believers **John Enarson** and **Zac Waller**, the Declaration represents a united front of pastors, theologians, and laypeople spanning the theological spectrum—from Anglican and Baptist to Charismatic and Non-denominational traditions. Anchoring the coalition are prominent leaders including **Pastor Dumisani Washington** (Founder, Institute for Black Solidarity with Israel) and **Rev. Dr. Gerald McDermott** (Anglican theologian and professor), as well as **Dr. Jim Garlow** (CEO, Well Versed). They are joined by ministry leaders from the U.S., Europe, and Israel, all uniting on a single conviction: this is not a matter of political disagreement, but of Christian moral failure.

"We are not addressing fringe voices. These platforms shape the worldview of over 70 million people monthly," said John Enarson, one of the Declaration's initiators. **"When error is broadcast at this scale, claiming the name of Jesus, the correction must be equally public. True biblical love does not mean staying silent in the face of evil."**

A Theological Stand, Not a Political Hit

The Declaration distinguishes itself by avoiding political partisanship, appealing instead to any believer of moral conscience, concerned with the integrity of the Church. **"We value political liberty. We are not silencing their legal right to speak; we are exercising our spiritual duty to rebuke,"** says John Enarson, **"We are moving beyond 'internet drama' to a formal declaration: these figures have crossed the line into unrepentant sin."** The Declaration cites the 9th Commandment ("Do not bear false witness") and the New Testament instruction to rebuke those who persist in sin "in the presence of all" (1 Timothy 5:20) as the basis for the statement.

The organizers emphasize that this is an internal Christian housekeeping matter. The website notes: *"We reject the grotesque hypocrisy of claiming to love the King of the Jews while reviling His kinsmen according to the flesh."* Offering educational resources, it implores pastors to address the problem publicly from the pulpit with their flock. *"If you don't teach about it, they will."*

The Scale of the Problem

The Declaration highlights data showing that Owens, Carlson, and Fuentes reach a combined audience of approximately **74 million monthly viewers**. The statement warns that these figures are "catechizing a generation of Christians into confident, unrepentant hatred" by mainstreaming false theories—such as Holocaust revisionism and medieval blood libels—under the guise of "Christian courage."

As a basis for the Declaration, a large compilation has been published with "[Supporting Evidence](#)"—explicit, repeated, and documented examples (with their sources) by Owens, Carlson, and Fuentes, illustrating a consistent pattern.

Call to Action

The Declaration invites all Christians of moral conscience to sign the document at [ChristianCallToTruth.org](#). It calls for:

1. **Public Repentance** from the named individuals.
2. **Biblical Discipline** from their local churches if they refuse.
3. **A Commitment** from the Church to stand as a "voice of truth and protection" for their Jewish neighbors.

"We declare unequivocally that these actions do not represent biblical Christianity, or Jesus. We call on Christians everywhere to speak out against this evil, and we commit ourselves to upholding truth in love."

"Silence in the face of this specific evil is no longer an option," implies the Declaration.
